DENALI NATIONAL PARK***

The most popular air tour. This flight takes you within six miles of McKinley's 20,320 ft. summit. Fly over the foothills of Denali to view the entire length of the Ruth Glacier, the Great Gorge (at over 9,000 feet, the world's deepest) and the massive south face of McKinley, where you may spot climbers headed to the summit. Make a photo-stop landing on a remote lake before returning to Anchorage.

***FLIGHT SEEING ADVENTURE
PRINCE WILLIAM SOUND GLACIER TOUR***

Prince William Sound is a magnificent region with over fifteen thousand square miles of fjords and inlets, dozens of tidewater glaciers and rugged mountain peaks. The sound's clear sea waters produce a rich marine life. Spot for Humpback or Killer whales, seals, eagles, otters and black bear. Make a photo-stop landing at a secluded cove. As an option, extend your tour by one-half hour and see Columbia Glacier, Prince William Sound's largest tidewater glacier. Then fly to Glacier Island to view sea lions sunning themselves on the rocky coastline.

Kenai River fly fishing guides offer truly unique, high quality full and half day guided fishing trips on the Upper and Middle Kenai River. Travel is required, but not included. We suggest securing accommodations in Cooper Landing the night before your trip. Please let us know if you would like assistance in booking transportation and/or accommodations.

All terminal tackle is provided, which includes:

- 20' Willie drift boats - up to 4 anglers per boat
- Flies, leaders, weights and necessary terminal tackle
- Loomis fly rods and Ross reels for Rainbow Trout fishing
- St. Croix fly rods and STH reels for Salmon fishing
- Hip waders, rain gear and life vests.

Clients are allowed to bring their own fishing gear, rain gear, and/or chest waders if they like.

What You Need to Bring:

- Warm Clothes - We recommend that you dress in layers. Try to bring wool or polar fleece as cotton holds in water and becomes uncomfortable when wet. A hat, gloves and non-cotton socks are also highly recommended.
- Rain Gear - Rain gear can be provided, but your own may be more comfortable.
- Polarized Sunglasses - If you have them.
- Fishing License - An Alaska fishing license valid for the day of the charter is required. Please purchase your fishing license in advance of your scheduled trip.
- Food & Drink - Please bring any food, snacks or non-alcoholic drink that you may want during your trip.
- Camera - Camera gear is encouraged. There is ample dry storage on the boat.

You are responsible for your gear. We recommend you keep it in a dry storage bag.

26 GLACIER CRUISE

The 26 Glacier Cruise travels over 135 miles into Prince William Sound where you will see 26 "named" glaciers and many more unnamed. We get face to face with these towering masses of ice, so close you can "hear" the glaciers move and gaze at their brilliant blues hues. On the 26 Glacier Cruise, you'll see several types of glaciers, including Alpine (hanging), Piedmont and Tidewater. Glacier calvings (when broken pieces of ice fall into the water and become icebergs) are normally seen on each cruise. And it's not just about the ice. It's very common to see sea otters, seals, porpoises, sea lions and whales during the cruise. You may also spot bear, mountain goats and bald eagles. At the end of the trip we stop at a bird rookery which is home to thousands of Kittiwakes.

- Lunch: Wild Alaska Cod lunch basket (chicken and vegetarian lunch basket with prior notice), coffee and tea.
